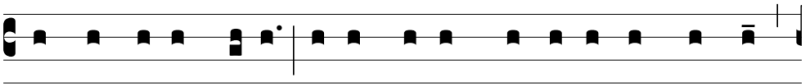

“Holy, holy, holy Lord.”

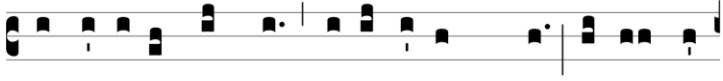
